Dear Fellow Parishioners:

It's Fall Festival time again! Our annual event is Sunday, October 21, 2018. Whole Hog Sausage and German Pot Roast Dinner will be served family style from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (dine-in or carry-out).

Work list: Please work the time and in the position assigned to you or find a replacement. If you cannot work your scheduled time or change with someone else, please contact the shift leader of your assigned time and workplace to let him/her know of the change. All shift leaders (*) are responsible for setting up their areas and getting all the necessary accessories.

The work list has been established from the parish membership/enrollment as of 7/29/2018. If you are no longer a member of the parish and/or know someone that is no longer a member, please call the parish office at 455-2320 or email to parishoffice@stjosephwestphalia.org. Extra copies of the work list will be in the back of church for anyone who did not receive one. If your name is not on the mailing list, please contact the parish office to have it added.

Raffle Tickets: Twelve raffle tickets are enclosed. Please return unsold raffle tickets to the raffle stand on the day of the festival. Sold raffle tickets may be turned in anytime by placing them and the money in an envelope marked "Raffle Tickets" and drop it into the collection basket. More tickets are available if you need them; contact a chairperson.

50-25-25 Tickets: Tickets will be sold for \$5 each, or 3 for \$10. Fifty percent of all proceeds will go to the parish, and there will be a drawing for two winners, each receiving 25% of the proceeds. Three 50-25-25 tickets are enclosed. Please return unsold tickets to the raffle stand on the day of the festival. Sold 50-25-25 tickets may be turned in anytime by placing them and the money in an envelope marked "50-25-25 Tickets" and drop it into the collection basket. More tickets are available if you need them; contact a chairperson.

Leftovers: The leftovers (sausage, beef, vegetables, pies, bread, etc.) will be sold after 7:00 pm in the dining room.

Each family is asked to donate the following:

- **\$10.00 toward the purchase of sausage, beef and vegetables** – Place money in marked envelope and drop in collection basket.
- **Baked Goods for the Kitchen OR Donation**
 - **Two fruit or cream pies, or comparable amount of servings of other desserts (cupcakes, cookies, brownies or cheesecake)** – please label. Cream pies and pumpkin pies should be brought to school in a cooler and placed immediately in a refrigerator.
 - **Two loaves of homemade bread** – please slice.
 - **Donations.** You may also donate \$19 to cover the cost of your baked goods. Donations may be placed in an envelope labeled "Pie and Bread" and placed in the collection basket by **SUNDAY, OCTOBER 14**. Please make checks payable to St. Joseph Parish.
- **Two or more items for the country store** (All types of homemade/homegrown items; turnips, molasses, apples, picked-out nuts, berry pies, jellies, jams, homemade bread, baked goods, pumpkins, plants, sweet potatoes, etc.)

Donated items can be dropped off before or after the Masses on Saturday and Sunday at the drop-off location in front of school. You may also drop your items off in the gym and cafeteria Sunday morning.

Thank you to all parishioners who go the extra mile to make the Fall Festival a success. We appreciate everyone's time and effort. We also appreciate everyone whose names no longer appear on the work list but have dedicated many years of service to our parish. We couldn't have a successful festival without the cooperation and support of all of our parishioners.
