Dear Parents,

I am hoping that the school year is getting off to a flying start! Mrs. Brandt will still be in my place this week although we are in communication daily. I am writing this the night before school begins for you, and you are all very much in my thoughts. I will leave this letter with Mrs. Brandt for her to add to as needed.

Reminders:

- Be sure to send in an extra change of clothes for your child including socks and underwear.
- Your child may wear their light blue Bulldogs Spirit shirts on Monday.
- Your second grader is asked to bring a ball cap for Monday to help in shielding their eyes from the eclipse.
- Please be sure to put sunscreen on your child on Monday since they will be outside more than usual.

This letter will include a list of homework to complete this week. If all is going according to plan, your child has two tests on Friday, August 25. If all is going according to plan, there will be a religion test over Chapter One Our Heavenly Father. They will need to read the chapter a couple of times with you. They will need to know the two parts of the Bible and be able to list an important person from each part of the Bible (Old Testament-Noah, for example). All information in the chapter and the accompanying workbook pages should be expected to be on the test. There is also a spelling test over the words circled on the Backpack Pages. These Backpack Pages are to be completed by Friday and turned in that day. They should be working on memorizing the names and locations of the continents, oceans and the Equator. They will also have to name their state and country and their capitals. This text will be upcoming some time during the week of the 28th. Your child may require extra time on a certain subject and may need to do more than what is listed to be ready for the test.

HOMEWORK: Backpack Pages 2-4 to be completed and turned in on Friday.

Monday: Read Chapter 1 in religion and begin practicing spelling list for tests on Friday.

Tuesday: Read Chapter 1 in the Decodable Reader and practice spelling list.

Wednesday: Practice spelling list and practice list of continents and oceans if they have this in their folder on the Bring Back side.

Thursday: Study for spelling and religion tests tomorrow.
