 - 2. Baptismal Certificate (if not baptized at St. Joseph Church)
 - 3. Health Record on shots
 - 4. Social Security Number

Once testing of all incoming Kindergarten students is complete a letter will be sent for acceptance, parent meeting date, and school information.
