Our Mission & Goal

Mission

The Mission of the Capital Campaign is to raise the funds necessary to repair and restore our church in order to provide our community with a sound and beautiful sanctuary where future generations can gather & grow in faith.

Goal

With our current liquid funds of \$292,000 from previous donations to the church renovation fund, our goal is to raise approximately \$1,469,886 over a three-year pledge period. Please understand that this pledge request is above and beyond your regular church tithing. We understand that each parish family may be at a different phase in their life financially, but we urge you to prayerfully consider your ability to give. It is our hope that through your generosity, we will be able to start Phase I of this campaign in the fall of 2018.
