Once testing of all incoming Kindergarten students is complete a letter will be sent for acceptance, parent meeting date, and school information.

If any SJS family knows of a new family that does not have students enrolled at St. Joseph, please pass this information on to them. Kindergarten information for testing will be place in the parish bulletin.
